

School Uniform Policy

Cambridge English School

Uniform is compulsory at Cambridge English School, as we feel that uniform has a positive impact on the learning and behaviour of our students. The School Uniform Policy will be adhered to by all students as they are expected to wear their uniform smartly at all times. Shirts must be tucked in, sleeves must be down and buttoned. Ties must also be worn properly during the time listed below. Parents of students who are persistently not wearing our school's full uniform will be contacted (Appendix A).

Detailed below is the correct school uniform:

Detailed below is the correct PE school uniform to be worn only on the day when your student has their PE lesson:

Boys are required to have hairstyles that are considered smart and respectful. They should not have coloured hair or any line or pattern shavings. Jewellery is not allowed, except for an appropriate watch (not 'smart watch').

Girls are required to have their hair tied back away from their face. They should not have coloured hair, make-up or nail varnish. Jewellery is not allowed, except for an appropriate watch and one pair of plain stud earrings through their ear lobes.

In line with Ministry of Education regulations, students are not allowed to bring a mobile phone or wear a smart watch. Any student with a mobile phone or wearing a smart watch will have the device confiscated by a member of staff. The device will be returned to the children at the end of the day on the first offence, please refer to the behaviour policy for repeated infringements. The school accepts no liability for loss or damage.

Summer Uniform

During the warmer, summer months, and subject to an announcement from the school, students are permitted to dispense with the tie, roll sleeves up or opt for PE polo shirt each day. The shirt should still be tucked in and leg-wear and shoes smart.
